Rules and Regulations

General Rules:

1. **Eligibility:**
 - Open to all Engineering (Degree & Diploma) students.
 - Participants can compete individually or in teams (max **2 members** per team).
 - I Card is compulsory to all
2. **Model Specifications:**
 - The model should be **self-explanatory** and align with one of the given topics.
 - Use of **eco-friendly** or **recycled materials** is encouraged.
3. **Presentation & Judging:**
 - Each team will have **10 minutes** to present their model.
 - Judges may ask questions related to design, feasibility, and sustainability.
 - The decision of the judges will be final.
4. **Judging Criteria:**
 - **Creativity & Innovation** – 20 marks
 - **Technical Feasibility** – 20 marks
 - **Sustainability & Environmental Impact** – 20 marks
 - **Presentation & Explanation** – 20 marks
 - **Use of Materials & Detailing** – 20 marks
 - **Total: 100 Marks**
5. **Prohibited Items:**
 - No hazardous materials, sharp objects, or explosive components allowed.
 - Electrical components can be used but must be safely installed.
6. **Awards & Prizes:**
 - Winner selection criteria will depend on **Best Model, Most Innovative Idea, and Best Presentation.**
 - Certificates will be awarded to all participants.

Rules and Regulations

1. General Rules:

2. Competition Format:

- Design Quality – Aesthetic and functional aspects.
- Speed & Efficiency – Completion within the given time.
- Creativity & Innovation – Unique and practical solutions.

4. Prizes & Certificates:

- Winners and runners-up will receive certificates & prizes.
- Participation certificates will be awarded to all.

Rules & Regulations:

- 1) Minimum Participants: 02
- 2) Explanation should less than 5 minutes.
- 3) Size of poster: A3 Topic of poster theme should be clearly mention at the top margin.
- 4) Poster should not contain any personal details like name, class, college etc.of the participants.These details should be mention in registration form only.
- 5) Register for the poster presentation with in the specified deadline(25 march).
